

Outcomes for students

Over the last two academic years, there has been an improvement in students' attainment in the A*-C range at GCSE, including those gaining 5 x A*-C. The number of students attaining 5 x A*-G has fallen overall but the attainment in English at this level has risen substantially over the last two years and there has been a very significant increase in those achieving a level 1 qualification in both English and Maths:
