

WSAPC ADVERSE WEATHER PROTOCOL & CHECKLIST

WSAPC aims to remain open in the event of adverse weather, however, in the event of disruption caused by adverse weather (ie heavy snow), the prime concern of WSAPC will always be the safety of the pupils and staff. Please remember that closures will be made on a centre by centre basis. (i.e. If weather conditions are poor in Crawley and a decision is made to close the Crawley Centre, this does not necessarily mean any other Centre will close).

The responsibility for making the decision to close a school lies with the Co-Headteachers in consultation with the Head of Centre and Chair of Governors.

In the event that a Centre closure is required, the following protocol should be followed to ensure that communication with stakeholders and interested parties is efficient and effective.
